It is hereby ordered pursuant to the Revised Case Management Order that the revised groupings are as follows:

Group 3: AC 2002-11-6365 through AC 2002-12-7141B

Group 4: AC 2002-12-7141C through AC 2002-12-7273A

Group 5: AC 2002-12-7273B through AC 2002-12-7407

Group 6: AC 2002-12-7409 through AC 2003-01-0114

Group 7: AC 2003-01-0116 through AC 2003-01-0696

Group 8: AC 2003-01-0697 through AC 2003-02-1202

Group 8 is a newly activated group with Day 1 on January 20, 2004.

It is hereby ordered that the revised trial dates for the above groups are as follows:

Group 3 remains the same on March 8, 2004.

Group 4 remains the same on May 3, 2004.

Group 5 is hereby set on May 17, 2004.

Group 6 is hereby set on June 1, 2004.

Group 7 is hereby set on June 14, 2004.


Group 8 is hereby set on July 12, 2004.

For Groups 4-7, work backwards from the trial dates on the revised case management order to determine the important dates and deadlines. The Court has provided a calendar as a guideline, however the revised case management order controls if there is a conflict.

The Court has determined that if the revised case management order is implemented for Group 3, counsel will lose 2 weeks of video taping time and the Court will gain two weeks of editing time. Therefore, unless there is an objection on or before January 28, 2004, for Group 3 only, the prior case management order will remain in effect.

There are several dates that fall on holidays or weekends. The closest business day shall be substituted when a date that requires filing or court action falls on a holiday or weekend. For instance, Group 5, Day 100 falls on a Sunday. The closest business day is the following Monday, but if it fell on a Saturday, the closest business day would have been the previous Friday. (ie. Group 4, Day 131 would be due 3/19/04 and not 3/20/04 since the Court is not open on Saturday.)

It is so ordered.
